We use a self-managed application process, which means that you are responsible for submitting, in one envelope, all the components of the application. PLEASE do not staple application or attachments.

Criteria for selection:

- Must have had an interruption in education of **at least two years**
- Pursuing a bachelor's degree at UCR in fall and attending all three quarters in 2019-20
- Must have a minimum 3.0 GPA
- Must be age 25 or older
- Can be an entering freshman, transfer student, or already enrolled UCR student
- Based on potential, past academic merit, and financial need
